

## RSS – Real Simple Syndication

Nelson & District Credit Union is keeping up with the times. The credit union homepage now offers members the ability to keep up with news and story updates automatically, by subscribing to an RSS Feed.



### What is RSS?

RSS (Real Simple Syndication) is a format for delivering regularly changing web content.

Many news-related sites, weblogs and other online publishers syndicate their content as an **RSS Feed** to whoever wants it. RSS subscribers will see when new content is made available, without them having to constantly check back to the site.

There are a number of ways to subscribe to an RSS feed, but the easiest way is to use one of the following web-browsers:-

- Internet Explorer 7 (for Windows)
- Firefox 2 (for Windows & Apple Mac)
- Safari (for Windows & Apple Mac)

### Benefits and Reasons for using RSS

- RSS allows you to stay informed, by retrieving the latest content from the sites you are interested in.
- You save time by not needing to visit each site individually on a regular basis.
- The number of sites offering RSS feeds is growing rapidly and includes big names like Nelson & District Credit Union!
